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	<p>Luis Fernandez handed out a packet with a one-year and second-year certificate proposal. Currently, High Schools have requested for the Management program, but one of the requirements for the program is that students need to pass their TSI assessment. With a one-year and two year certificate the TSI is waived allowing any High School students to take the program.</p> <p>Angelina Ramon mentioned the importance of having a computer course to help students be ready for the workforce. There are managers out there that are lacking computer skills; they do not know how to utilize spreadsheets (Excel) and presentation (Powerpoint).</p> <p>Victoria Dühring shared that Administrative Information Technology and Management program are two different programs that teach different skills for their appropriate field. Victoria added that students attending the Management program should have experience in software application from High School experience.</p>																																									

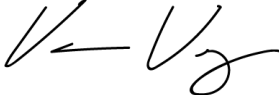
