Description of Job Duties: Primary duties include teaching freshmen and sophomore level courses in teaching discipline, such as History of the Theater, Acting, and Stagecraft. This instructor will recruit and advise students, serve on college committees, and direct a student drama production once per academic year. This instructor has responsibility for developing and updating curriculum, textbook/equipment selection, and instructional materials. Experience in teaching/advising/mentoring low income, first generation, educationally disadvantaged and at-risk students is desirable. Work rules, code of conduct, and other policies are part of the essential functions of the job.

Salary: Commensurate with education and teaching experience based on SWTJC salary schedule. Nine month, non-tenure track, faculty position.

Other Benefits: Benefits package available (Health/Life insurance, retirement plan, sick/personal leave, holidays, and waived tuition for eligible employees and dependents).

QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS

Education, Experience & Training: Master's degree in Drama/Theater or Master's degree with a minimum of eighteen (18) graduate hours in the teaching discipline required.

Additional Qualification Requirements: Must possess the required knowledge, skills, abilities and experience to be able to explain and demonstrate, with or without reasonable accommodations, the essential functions of the job. Experience in working with diverse populations is desirable. Candidate must be authorized to work in the U.S. and must provide verifiable credentials; successful completion of the reference and background check specified for the position. Travel may be required periodically to other geographic locations served by the college. Must have a valid driver's license and be insurable through SWTJC insurers.
