Construction

Future Expansion

As of this Thursday we received the proceeds from our bond sale and monies will be invested in cd's until we finalize the plans for Eagle Pass and Crystal City.

Crystal City – No new developments for Crystal City. We had planned for the architect to be down to visit the site; however, he had to reschedule due to a family emergency.

Eagle Pass — We continue to refine the plans for Eagle Pass. A major concern on this project is the availability of parking spaces after construction. We are looking at the option of a multi-story building to try to conserve as much parking as possible.

Partnerships/Community

We are hosting Angelo State University on our Del Rio & Eagle Pass Campuses next week. We are signing articulation agreements to strengthen our pre engineering programs and offering more opportunities to our engineering students.

Several college administrators attended the UCISD strategic planning session and volunteered to assist the district through this process.

I made a presentation to the Uvalde Rotary club, updating them on activities of SWTJC.

Other

Strategic Plan –We should be in a position to have a report with requested modifications by the April Board meeting.
